Daniel Boone Home and Boonesfield Village, owned and operated by Lindenwood University, will hold its Louisiana Purchase Day event on June 14. Throughout the day presentations will be conducted by interpreters who will bring history to life in buildings throughout Boonesfield Village. Special tours of the historic Daniel Boone Home can also be added to the day's activities.

Events and activities will be centered around the Louisiana Purchase with an early afternoon flag ceremony as the

highlight of the day illustrating the changing of the flags from Spanish to French and then to the United States. Many activities will be going on prior and after the changing of the flags.

Throughout the day, prior to the flag ceremony, there will be speeches by dignitaries, soldiers and civilians as well as reenactments of special meetings regarding the new purchase by the United States.

County Council Schedules Public Hearing on Master Plan

The St. Charles County Council will officially get the Master Plan 2020 document at 7 p.m. June 9 in the Council Chambers, and a public hearing on the issue will be held at the beginning of that meeting.

Council Chairman Dan Foust said he would like the public to submit input in advance of the meeting as well as that from those who would like to come to the meeting and speak.

Comments can be made online or by e-mailing council@sccmo.org or mailing comments to County Council, Executive Office Building, 100 North Third Street, Suite 124, St. Charles, MO 63301.

The Council also will hold a work session at 5 p.m. on June 9 prior to the regular meeting. Items to be discussed will be the Master Plan and the County Road Board's participation in the reconstruction of New Town Boulevard in St. Charles. Officials from the city will be on hand to explain their

proposal.

That issue was to have come up earlier in a work session, prior to the May 27 meeting, but John Greifzu, director of transportation for the County, would be unavailable for that meeting. Then Foust tried to schedule the work session for June 2, but St. Charles Mayor Patti York was unavailable for that date, so the work session now is scheduled for June 9.

The Council's last meeting in May will be on Tuesday, May 27, because of Memorial Day holiday on Monday, May 26.

New Melle Art Show and Reception

Planning has begun for our annual New Melle Art Show and Reception which will be Friday, August 22, 2008 at the New Melle Lakes Golf Course and Banquet Center. As in the past, the evening features a professional art show and sale, wine tasting, hors d'oeuvres, music, and a souvenir wine glass, and sponsorship opportunities for area businesses.

This year's show will be a little different in that all of the participating artists produce three-dimensional artwork such as blown glass, pottery, wood carving, etc. Featured artists include: Bob Allen - Pottery/Ceramics (returning from 2006), Jim Liefeld - Wood Carving, Brendan Bayless - Blown Glass, Nancy McKinley - Indian Gourd Art (returning from 2005), Jean Hollingsworth - Pine Needle Baskets and a jewelry artist to be announced.
